Circular Economy Self-Rate Tool

An online, interactive, user-friendly self-rating tool aimed at representatives and experts working in manufacturing, craft and construction SMEs and micro-enterprises to recognise their company's strengths, their weaknesses and the areas they may need greater focus on.



Circular Economy Experts Course

Online training sessions on Circular Economy specialised in construction and manufacturing SMEs and micro-enterprises, adaptable to the needs of each business sector. New skills and competences individuals that will support the CE transition.



Circular Economy Implementation Framework

A step-by-step framework for SMEs and micro-enterprises that will show them how to scale up by understanding, utilising and investing in a Circular Economy, how to manage resources more efficiently and be friendlier to the environment.

Results of our multiplier events

In the last stage of the project the partners organized multiplier events in 5 countries with more than 230 participants.

The goal of the multiplier event was to

- demonstrate the REFRAME interactive online tool and the practical applicability of the REFRAME

- ask and encourage stakeholders' feedback and evaluation.



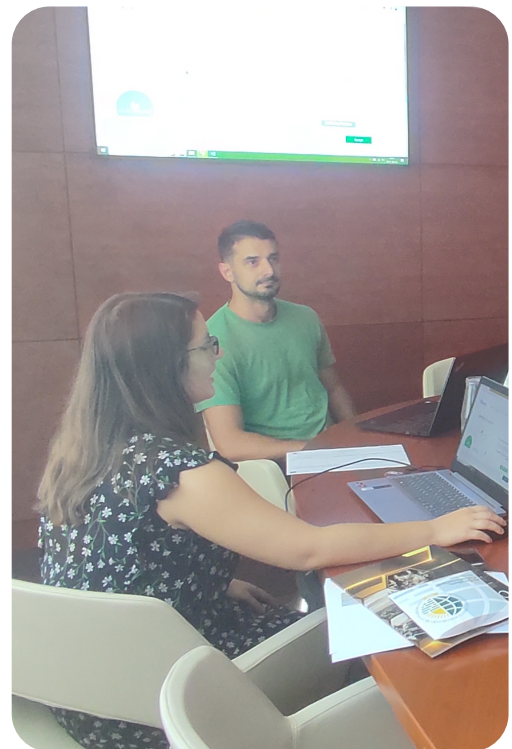
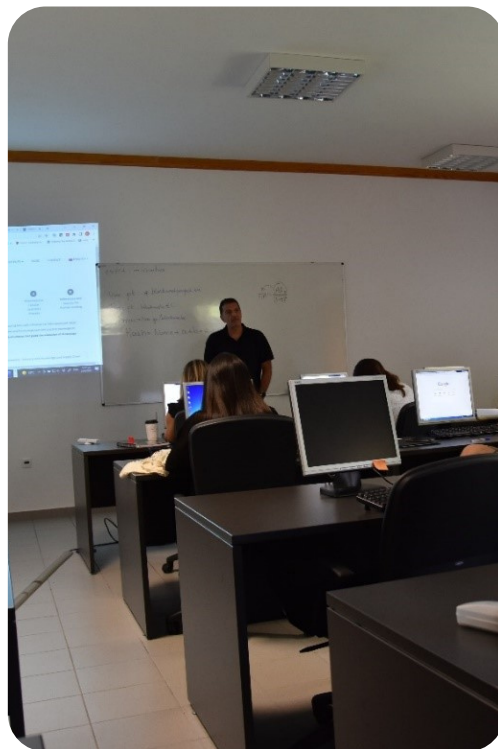
Stakeholders in focus

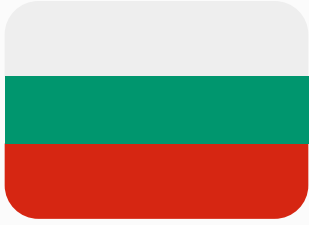


Results of our stakeholder meetings

Under the REFRAME project all partners have mapped the stakeholders of the project in order to inform them about the objectives and the results of the project. The partners have involved them into the development phase of the intellectual outputs and gained valuable feedback from them. Stakeholders showed interest in using the tools and gave a positive feedback about the REFRAME project.

The partners had stakeholder meeting with almost 40 stakeholders online and in person during project. The stakeholders were representatives of the project's target groups, policy makers, business development organisations, associations and clusters.





Transnational Partner Meeting in Vratsa

In April 2022, the project partners met for the second time in person in Vratsa, Bulgaria to discuss final steps of the project.

During the two-days meeting, partners discussed testing phase of the intellectual outputs and the organisation of the multiplier events where the final products were presented.
