

PILOT ACTIONS?


Interreg Europe program is all about exchanging experiences and knowledge between regions. Pilot Actions add more activity-bases flavor to interregional cooperation, and their purpose is to test a new approach to public intervention.



FIRST BATCH OF GOOD PRACTICES PUBLISHED ON TOURBO SITE



Identifying good practices is the cornerstone of an Interreg Europe project. In TOURBO, the aim is to find good practices that support the MSMEs in the twin transition of tourism industry. TOURBO aims to identify 24 good practices during the project, and share them with everyone for policy development.



The aim of the good practices of the TOURBO project is to improve the sustainability of the tourism industry with the help of digitalisation in a way, that is accessible and possible for the MSMEs in tourism. In other words, TOURBO is especially interested in good practices, that help the MSMEs improve their operations and sustainability utilising the possibilities offered by digitalisation. Partners suggest practices from their region, share and discuss them together with other regions, and finally an external expert evaluates the suggested practices before they are published.

Now the first batch of nine good practices has been published on the TOURBO website. They range from digital tools to ways of working together.

FIRST PEER REWIEV MEETING IN CROATIA



On November 9th 2024, TOURBO project partners from all 8 partner organisations gathered for the first time to peer-review the freshly identified good practices in Koprivnica-Križevci region in Croatia.



TOURBO partners in all regions have mapped what is already done in regards to boosting sustainability and digitalisation of tourism sector in their regions, in other words indentifying good practices. In this two-day event the first round of nine good practices from seven of project countries were presented to the partners and stakeholders. Also the upcoming **pilot actions** were presented and discussed with the partners. On the second day these themes were elaborated in a discussion panel on the topic of "Branding of regional tourism as part of the green and digital transition".

In addition to the well facilitated discussions about how the presented good practices can inspire policy making and imposeve the competitivenes of MSMEs in different regions, TOURBO partners and stakeholders had the opportunity to enjoy the hospitality of our Croatian partners and experience and discuss the regional examples of tourism, like the Visitor Center "Đurđevac sands" with a tour of the Old Town Đurđevac, and on the second day the 25th Craft and Economic Fair in Križevci.





>>> PROJECT SUMMARY

TOURBO offers an innovative approach to a crucial priority for the EU: Enabling Public Authorities and MSMEs to develop TWIN TRANSITION Strategies to stimulate economic development of the regions. The Covid-19 pandemic, the war in Ukraine, as well as digitalisation and climate change, have highlighted the importance of government resilience in the face of unexpected shocks and stresses. And they have also demonstrated the transformative role of digital technologies in helping the public and private sectors solve urgent challenges and remain resilient during a crisis. Small and medium-sized enterprises are crucial to the EU economy: they account for more than 99% of European businesses and provide two-thirds of private sector jobs. The twin transition will strengthen sustainability through technology and enable a sustainable digital transformation for European tourism MSMEs.

This project will identify and share innovative and best practices to improve the transition to "Industry 4.0" in tourism-related MSMEs (such as small accommodation operators, restaurants, small local craft businesses, small tourism service providers, etc.). The use of digital approaches and new technology solutions can help accelerate European sustainability policies while creating more responsive, intelligent and inclusive local and regional governance strategies.

TOURBO will create a sustainable and progressive framework for the integration of a resilient tourism sector into local and regional policies, especially with the aim of the transition pathway of MSMEs by a quadruple-helix approach for a smart-green transformation.

- * Develop innovative SMART-GREEN-METHODS in tourism-related MSMEs.
- * Build the capacity of tourism-related MSMEs to become more resource efficient
